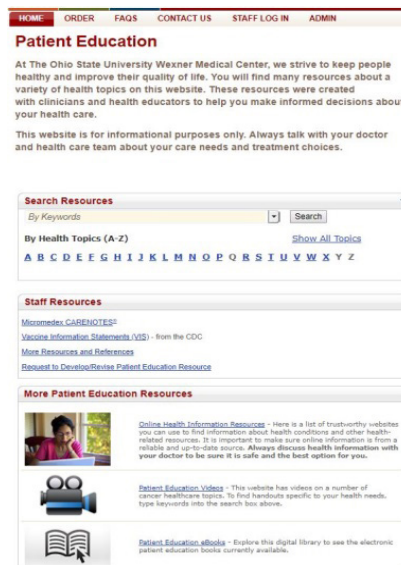


# Cancer Patient Education Resources at The James

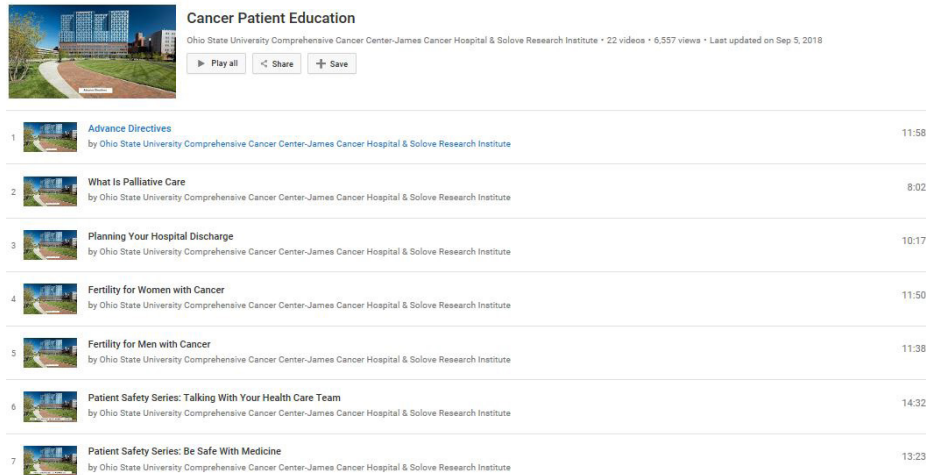
To get this helpful information:
