The Ohio State University College of Dentistry

Postle Hall Dental Clinics, 305 W. 12th Avenue, Columbus, OH 43210, phone: 614-688-3763

- Open for adult walk-ins during these hours:
 - 8:30 am – 1:30 pm on Monday-Thursday
 - 7:30 am – Noon on Wednesday, or at 25 patients maximum
 - 7:30 am – 11:30 am on Friday, or at 20 patients maximum
- If it is a busy day, you may be asked to come back the next day for care.
- The fee for an exam and single x-ray is \$38.00 and one tooth extraction is \$89.00, paid at the time of registration. Added fees will be charged if more treatment is needed.
- Medicaid is accepted with photo identification.
- If you have OSU Dental, OSU student health care, CareSource, or Molina, please bring your card and photo identification.
- Call 614-688-3763 to make an appointment or for more information.

Ohio State's Rardin Family Practice, Clinica Latina

- Open for adult and child walk-ins from 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm, the 1st Tuesday of the month.
- Come early. The first 25 patients are seen.
- The clinic gives free screenings, dental cleanings, preventative sealants, and simple restorative procedures.

- Emergency dental care for extractions only.
- A donation of \$5.00 per extraction is requested.

Vineyard Free Medical Clinics

- A dental clinic is available for adults and children. Call Fridays between 9:00 am - 9:45 am to schedule appointments. Line may be busy so keep trying.
- The clinic hours are 9:00 am – 10:00 am, the 1st and 4th Fridays of each month.
- The clinics provides dental exams, fillings, extractions, and cleanings. They do not provide root canals, bridgework, orthodontics (braces), or dentures.

PrimaryOne Health - Primary Dental Services

- **Emergency services** are available at each location at 7:45 AM each day on a first come, first serve walk-in basis. Bring a photo ID, either proof of income or a dental insurance card, and for those without insurance a \$40 minimum payment.
- Appointments can be made for adults and children who live in the Columbus area for preventive exams, routine checkups, x-rays, cleanings, fluoride treatments, sealants, fillings, tooth extractions, and front teeth root canals.
 - Accept Medicaid, CareSource, Molina, Atena, Anthem, Medical Mutual, Doral Dental, and Aultra Dental insurance.
 - For uninsured patients, fees are on a sliding scale based on family size and monthly income.
